

Door to Door Solicitation

On July 25, 2023, the Hartselle City Council adopted Ordinance 1592, a new door-to-door solicitation ordinance. This ordinance was revised on May 27, 2025, by Ordinance 1632 to remove the requirement for political candidates and religious organizations to obtain a permit before going door to door.

However, candidates must still adhere to the hours set forth in the ordinance for door-to-door solicitation of 8:30 AM to 7:30 PM. They must also follow the ordinance requirements of adhering to the “No Solicitation Registry” meaning if a citizen has signed up for this list (located on the City’s website) or their property is posted with a “No Solicitation or No Trespassing” sign, you as a candidate are prohibited from knocking on their door or leaving campaign literature at their residence.
