

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF HARTSELLE, ALABAMA  
JULY 19, 2018**

The City Council of the City of Hartselle, Alabama, met in a Special Called Meeting at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 19, 2018, inside the Council Chambers at the Hartselle Municipal Building. Council President Kenny Thompson called the meeting to order.

Council Member Virginia Alexander led the invocation. Council Member Chuck Gill led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The following were present for the meeting: Council President Thompson, Council Members Chuck Gill, Virginia Alexander and Matt Broom, and City Clerk-Controller Rita S. Lee, who also acted as Secretary of the meeting. Council Member Dwight Tankersley, Mayor Randy Garrison, and City Attorney Larry Madison were absent. Having a quorum present, Council President Thompson declared the proceedings open for business.

Council President Thompson called on Council Member Chuck Gill to discuss the Special Events Alcohol License application for BB's Back Porch dba Pig Stand. Council Member Gill explained that Mr. Robbie Bell, owner of BB's Back Porch dba Pig Stand, had submitted a Special Events Alcohol License application to the City and if approved, the license would allow him to sell alcoholic beverages at the Cotton Pickin' BBQ Cook-Off to be held July 27-28, 2018 at 500 Nanceford Road S.W. He also stated that if approved, alcohol would be sold in a designated area and would be strictly monitored. Council President Thompson declared a public hearing open for discussion. No comments were made. Council Member Gill motioned to close the public hearing; Council Member Alexander seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote. Council Member Broom motioned to approve the Special Events Alcohol License; Council Member Gill seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Council President Thompson called for comments from the Mayor, Council Members and the City Attorney. None were made.

Council President Thompson called for comments from the audience. None were made.

With no other business to come before the Council, Council Member Gill motioned to adjourn; Council Member Broom seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote and the meeting adjourned at 8:01.
