

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF HARTSELLE, ALABAMA
SEPTEMBER 1, 2020**

The City Council of the City of Hartselle, Alabama, met in a special called session at 12:00 P.M. on Tuesday, September 1, 2020, inside the Council Chambers at the Hartselle Municipal Building. Council President Pro-Tempore Dwight Tankersley called the meeting to order.

Mayor Randy Garrison gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The following were present for the meeting: Council President Pro-Tempore Dwight Tankersley, Council Members Virginia Alexander and Matt Broom. Mayor Randy Garrison, City Attorney Larry Madison, and City Clerk-Controller Rita S. Lee, who also acted as Secretary of the meeting. Council President Kenny Thompson and Council Member Chuck Gill were absent from the meeting. Having a quorum present, Council President Pro-Tempore Tankersley declared the proceedings open for business.

Council President Pro-Tempore Tankersley called on City Clerk-Controller, Rita S. Lee, to tabulate the provisional ballots from the August 25th Municipal Election. Ms. Lee read the report from the Morgan County Board of Registrars concerning the three (3) provisional ballots cast. She announced that all were deemed valid registered voters. City Attorney Madison assisted Ms. Lee in calling out the results from the provisional ballots.

Council President Pro-Tempore Tankersley then asked the Council to adopt Resolution 20-0901 to officially canvass the election results of the August 25th Municipal Election. Council Member Alexander motioned to approve Resolution 20-0901; Council Member Broom seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Council President Pro-Tempore Tankersley then called for a motion to issue a Certificate of Election to each of the following:

- Virginia Alexander, City Council Place 4
- Ken Doss, City Council Place 5
- Monty Vest, School Board Place 1
- Daxton Maze, School Board Place 4

Council Member Broom motioned to adopt Certificates of Election; Council Member Alexander seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Council President Pro-Tempore Tankersley asked for comments from the Mayor, Council Members, and City Attorney. No other comments were made.

Council President Pro-Tempore Tankersley asked for comments from the audience. No other comments were made.

There being no other business to come before the Council, Council Member Broom motioned to adjourn the meeting; Council Member Alexander seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote and the meeting adjourned at 12:16 p.m.
