

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF HARTSELLE, ALABAMA
FEBRUARY 9, 2021**

The City Council of the City of Hartselle, Alabama, met in a regular session at 7:00 P.M. on Tuesday, February 9, 2021, inside the Council Chambers at the Hartselle Municipal Building. Council President Kenny Thompson called the meeting to order.

Council Member Dwight Tankersley gave the invocation. Council Member Ken Doss led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The following were present for the meeting: Council President Kenny Thompson, Council Members Dwight Tankersley, Virginia Alexander, Chuck Gill, and Ken Doss. City Attorney Larry Madison and City Clerk-Controller Rita S. Lee, who also acted as Secretary of the meeting, were present for the meeting. Mayor Randy Garrison was absent. Having a quorum present, Council President Thompson declared the proceedings open for business.

Council President Thompson called for approval of the minutes of the regular meeting held on Tuesday, January 26, 2021. Council Member Alexander motioned to approve the minutes as presented; Council Member Doss seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Council President Thompson addressed the only item on the agenda, to request to consider a budget adjustment from Public Works and called on Public Works Director Curtis Self to discuss the request with the Council. Mr. Self explained the department had recently sold several surplus items on GOVDeals and was requesting the total dollar amount of the items sold, \$15,007.00, be transferred to the department's Minor Equipment line item 01-301-5503 to be used to purchase a new trailer to safely transport the departments newly purchased heavier Mini X. Council Member Doss motioned to approve the budget adjustment request as presented; Council Member Gill seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Council President Thompson asked for comments from the Council Members or City Attorney. Council Member Alexander thanked everyone for the flowers, calls, texts and cards she received following the death of her Mother. No other comments were made.

Council President Thompson asked for comments from the audience. Police Chief Barley gave a brief update on plans to do some updates to the PD building. No comments were made.

There being no other business to come before the Council, Council Member Gill motioned to adjourn the meeting; Council Member Tankersley seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote and the meeting adjourned at 7:04p.m.
