The City of Hartselle is pleased to announce the restart of recycle pick-up for Hartselle residents starting October 2021. Recycle pick-up will occur on a bi-weekly basis. Please refer to the calendar for the schedule. Also, please pay close attention to weeks that include holidays as the schedule has to be adjusted to allow for these holidays.

* To help keep the recycle program viable, we ask and need all residents to put only the proper recyclable items into their recycle cart. Non-recyclable materials and food contaminated items are not allowed to be put into the recycle cart. Garbage and non-recyclable items need to be put into the garbage cart. Items for recycle are: papers, plastics, cardboards, aluminum & tin cans. **NO GLASS OF ANY KIND!!**

The Public Works Department also needs residents to only put the proper waste into their green yard waste cart. The green cart is for vegetation yard waste only. Please do not put garbage or any type of lumber into this container as this contaminates the load for the disposal process. Please only put grass, leaves, small limbs & clippings into this can.
